

SUPER SANITISER

DESCRIPTION

SUPER SANITISER incorporates anionic and non-ionic surfactants, foam stabilisers and boosting agents in combination with a broad spectrum antimicrobial agent, creating an efficient foam cleaning compound for positive cleaning action in the food plant. The concentrated foam clings to surfaces allowing effective penetration of the emulsifiers thus loosening/removing proteinaceous matter, blood, fats and other contaminants.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

In conjunction with a foam gun, a dilution of 1:50 with water is recommended. For manual scrubbing of surfaces a dilution of 1:80 is recommended. Rinse product contacting surfaces with clean potable water.
