It is suitable for use with all classifications of washing including polyester blends.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

LAUNDRY POWDER may be used as a complete one shot laundry detergent or in conjunction with KWIKMASTER BLEACH. Use at a rate of 25-30g/kg of dry weight washing depending on the degree of soiling.
